Councilman Ghormley moved to adopt Ordinance 2023-17. The motion was seconded by Councilman Claycamp. Discussion. The motion passed 5-0.

Councilman Schoneboom moved to pass Resolution 23-05. The motion was seconded by Councilman Smith. The motion passed 5-0.

Executive Session
